California Privacy Rights

The California Consumer Privacy Act of 2018 (“CCPA”) provides California residents with certain rights with respect to their personal information collected by businesses. If you are a California resident, you may exercise the following rights regarding your Information, subject to certain exceptions and limitations:

- **The right to know** the categories and specific pieces of Information we collect, use, disclose about you, the categories of sources from which we collected your Information, our purposes for collecting or selling your Information, the categories of your Information that we have disclosed for a business purpose, and the categories of third parties with which we have shared Information;
- **The right to request that we delete the Information** we have collected from you or maintain about you.
- **The right not to receive discriminatory treatment** for the exercise of the privacy rights conferred by the CCPA

The categories and sources of personal Information we collect and the business or commercial purposes for collecting personal information are described in our Privacy Policy.
